

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. Any competitor lodging an objection must do so in writing within 10 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £20, and in the event of the objection not being upheld, will forfeit the deposit. VERBAL OBJECTIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
3. Health & Safety - The organiser has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards.
4. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses in connection with or arising out of the Show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers and landowners against any legal action arising from such accidents and in this respect it shall be incumbent upon competitors to ensure they hold adequate third party insurance.
5. The organisers reserve the right to vary the order and the composition of the schedule according to circumstances if necessary.
6. No entry fees will be returned without a vet or doctor's certificate presented within 7 days of the show.
7. Late entries will be accepted on the day at £1.00 extra if space permits. However, as entries for some classes will be restricted, early entry is recommended.
8. In the case of cancellation due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances £2.00 will be kept from each entrant for administrative costs. If in doubt please call 874407/0795 199 5192.
9. No entries will be accepted without remittance.
10. Hard hats must be worn at all times by riders whilst mounted and correct dress worn in all classes. It is compulsory for all Pony Club competitors, and recommended for all riders, to wear hats conforming to BS EN 1384, PAS 015 or ASTM F1163 in all competitions
11. No earrings or Jewellery.
12. No horse or pony under 4 years to be entered into any ridden class.
13. All classes will be run under 2009 Pony Club Rules and BSJA Rules where applicable
14. No cantering outside practice area, riders not adhering to this will be asked to leave the showground.
15. Any person seen mistreating any animal will be asked to leave the showground.
16. No whips or spurs are allowed in gymkhana events.
17. No Stallions or Colts.
18. No horses to be left unattended in the horse box parking area.
19. It is a condition of entry that each Competitor agrees to abide by the above rules.
20. Please take all litter home and please do not muck out horseboxes on showground.
21. A deposit of £10 will be requested for each trophy, this will be refunded upon the safe return of the trophy by 31st May 2010.

RING ONE – 9am start

- Class 1 **Absolute Novice Jumping**
Combination pony/horse/rider not to have won £20 on or before 01.01.09.
Jumps approx 2' first round. Rosettes to 6th place
- Class 2 **Junior Novice Jumping** - Rider aged 16 years and under.
Combination pony/horse/rider not to have won £20 on or before 01.01.09.
Jumps approx 2'3" first round. Rosettes to 6th place
- Class 3 **Senior Novice Jumping** – Rider aged 17 years and over
Open Height. Rider any age. Jumps approx 2'6" first round.
Rosettes to 6th place
- Class 4 **Intermediate** - Open Height. Rider any age. Jumps approx 2'9" first round. Rosettes to 6th place.
- Class 5 **Open** - Open Height. Rider any age. Jumps 3' in first round. Rosettes to 6th place
- Class 6 **Pairs - Mini & Major - Mini = rider 10 years and under, pony under 14.2hh, Major = rider over 10 years horse any height.** Mini jumps 1'6", major jumps 2'3".
Pair to jump consecutively. Fastest pair against the clock.
Rosettes to 6th place.

RING TWO – 9am start

- Class 7 **Mini Minimus** - 10 years & under on/off lead rein. Approx height 1'.
- Class 8 **Minimus** - Rider any age. May be assisted but not led. Approx height 1'3 to 1'6".
- Class 9 **Mickey Mouse** - Rider any age. Approx height 1'9" - 2'.
- Class 10 **Golden Oldies - Horse/rider combined age of over 45 years.**
Approx height 2'3" to 2'6". Rosettes to 6th place
- Class 11 **Road Runners Scurry** - Approx height 2'3" – 2'6". Rosettes to 6th place.
- Class 12 **Nomination Knockout** - Approx height 2' in first round. Rosettes to 6th place.
